Responding to Threats and Violence Programme RTVF24 Leading to a Security Institute of Ireland Certificate at Foundation Level

Synopsis

This programme is designed as a supporting vocational programme for those working with the public, with face-to-face interactions. It is a short 8 hour in person practical programme covering the initial responses to an attack such as an attempted strike or grab. While designed with the security industry in mind it is applicable to all areas where the threat of personal attack exists, this includes work related risks. It is also beneficial to those who feel vulnerable in any personal or non-work-related setting.

Requirements for Entry and Certification

- You must sign a Health and Fitness declaration.
- You will need to provide your Personal Public Service Number (PPSN).
- You must be over eighteen years of age.
- You must be competent in the English language.
- You must complete the Security Institute of Ireland Registration Form

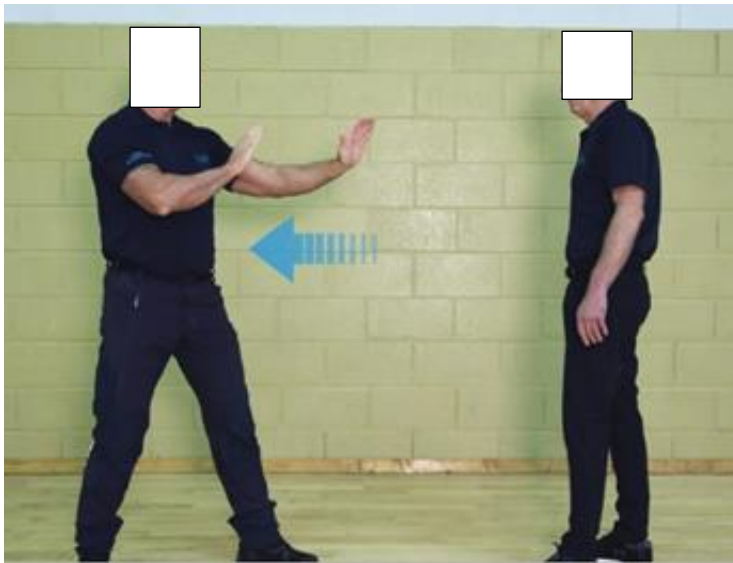

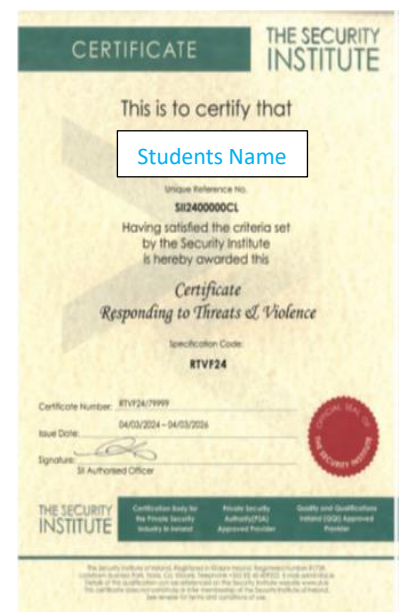
